1. Child and infant CPR require (36; 304–305):

3. Before beginning CPR, determine (34; 304):
  - a. if there is any injury to the chest
  - b. that the patient is unconscious/unresponsive
  - c. if the patient has a medical condition
  - d. if the patient has medical coverage
4. To perform chest compressions on an infant (37; 305):
  - a. place the heel of one hand in about the center of the chest
  - b. compress slowly
  - c. use two fingers of 1 hand to compress the chest
  - d. compress the chest  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch deep
5. To provide rescue breathing (36–37; 304–305):
