1. To perform chest compressions on a child (37):

3. To perform chest compressions on an infant (37):
 - a. place the heel of one hand in about the center of the chest
 - b. compress slowly
 - c. use two fingers to compress the chest
 - d. compress the chest $\frac{1}{2}$ inch deep
4. Child and infant CPR require (36):
 - a. 3 compressions and one breath
 - b. 5 compressions and one breath

5. To provide rescue breathing (36–37):
